Little Money Often Can Make Lot of Money
Denver, Oct. 2 (AP)—If you happen to find a Indian head penny dated 1877 that's in reasonably good condition, don't waste it. It's worth anywhere from \$5 to \$10. And a \$2 roll of nickels minted in Denver in 1942 is worth \$25 to collectors—if the coins are still shiny and unmarked. These are a couple of examples of how a little money can make a lot of money for anyone who rounds up some scarce items of hard cash, says Dan Brown, president of the Rocky Mountain Numismatic Association. The 1877 penny is valuable because only 852,000 were minted and 70 years is a long time in the life of a lowly one-center. Take the 1932 quarter minted in Denver. Only 436,800 were struck off, Brown said, and one of them in tiptop shape is valued at \$20.
